Ride descends the Hambleden valley and takes in Hambleden Lock (walk over the lock and weir), Henley, passing by the house where George Harrison lived, Stoke Row to visit Maharajah's Well (nearby village store for drinks possibly), Benson (on the Thames) for lunch. Return via Russell's Water, Maidensgrove, Stonor valley, The Barn at Turville Heath for coffee, passing Turville Grange which Henry Ford once owned and Christmas Common. I don't think we'll get an accurate forecast until a couple of days ahead and if it's just showers and 21 degrees we'd be happy to do the ride." The ride will start from the Rufus Centre cafe on Steppingley Road. MK45 1AH. We have been given permission to use their car park overflow field as I said we'd get a coffee in their cafe prior to the ride. please leave any cars in the field in the corner to leave the main car park free for vaccination centre attendees. For those who don't wish to pollute the atmosphere with exhaust fumes(or exploit third-world labour for lithium extraction), you can join Steve and me on the 9.38 train from St Albans (9.46 Harpenden) which arrives at Flitwick at 9.53. turn right out of the station down Steppingley road past Tesco to reach the centre after a mile. (£7.20 return with a railcard) The ride will leave at 10.30 and do a loop round The Brickhills and Woburn, then have lunch at the Church End, Eversholt pub The Green Man after about 20 miles. The pub is quite posh, but they do a vegetarian and non-vegetarian sourdough sandwich each lunchtime. Puddings are probably great as the pub is run by Candice who won the British Bake-off a few years ago! There is a picnic option by the church or recreation ground nearby. After lunch we'll head north east for a 15 mile loop to Ampthill Park and the cafe kiosk for a tea stop before a quick 5 miles back to the station or the cars. (if it's raining we can use cafes in Ampthill instead) There are trains back to St Albans about every 15mins. For those who wish to travel by car I suggest you park in a residential street, The Avenue, just off the A1 at post code SG19 1ER. I could not find any free car parks in Sandy. To get to the station should be a five-minute cycle ride east along Bedford Road, then south on the B1042. For those who wish to travel on the train, you can join Steve and me on the 9.19 train from Hatfield (9.26 WGC) which arrives at Sandy at 10.04 after a change at Hitchin (with no platform change) for £7.75 with a railcard. The ride will leave at 10.15 and do a loop up to Grafham Water, where we can have a late brunch, after about 18 miles, at the Harbour View café, then a tea stop at the lovely Waresley Garden centre after another 18 miles, before a short seven miles or so back to Sandy." See details below: "The intention is to visit one of the main airfields from which the WWII Mosquito aircraft operated. Linkage for the 40+ being the Mosquito Museum at Salisbury Hall. We will be met at the airfield by Denis Sharp who runs the airfield preservation society for a talk/exploration of what is left of the site. There is a useful video on Youtube (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=NQSPXTNR2OA) with the Hunsdon interest starting just after 13 minutes in. You might find a pre-visit to the refurbished museum interesting - but there are no plans for questions. We will meet at Hatfield (White Lion Square) at 10:00 for 10:30 departure - going to The Fox in Hunsdon village. After lunch we go the airfield and meet Denis there. How long we stay will depend on our level of interest. He can give a short talk using maps and photos or he can take us around (trainer shoes or similar are recommended for the wooded sections). Don't fit your expensive slick tyres as old concrete runways are pretty rough. My route to Hunsdon is 23 miles via Hertingfordbury, Thunderidge and Cold Christmas Lane, then Wareside and finally Hunsdon. This takes in Anchor Lane which is formally closed but was passable on bike when I last tried. With major roadworks going on in the area who knows what it will be like in September so a re-route may be needed. Coming back I suggest a shorter route - to Ware and the straight along to Hertford and Hatfield. Stopping off in Hertford perhaps, depending on time."
